**M**innie Marie Toben, 1920-2012. Our beloved mother, grandmother and great-grandmother, Minnie Toben, fell asleep in Jesus on June 14, 2012, with her daughter Marsha at her side. Born in Rock Falls, Illinois, on August 6, 1920, Minnie was married to William Toben on April 4, 1942. Minnie and Bill moved to Tucson following their wedding, and Minnie lived in Tucson seventy years. Minnie and Bill had four children: William of Tucson; Marsha Krueger of Carlsbad, CA; Ruth Losurdo of Batavia, IL; and John of Holland, MI. Minnie's husband Bill passed away in 1980. Minnie was a housewife and mother until her youngest son entered high school. She then worked at Bullards for twenty-four years until the store closed in 1994.
