God bless you mom and rest in peace.

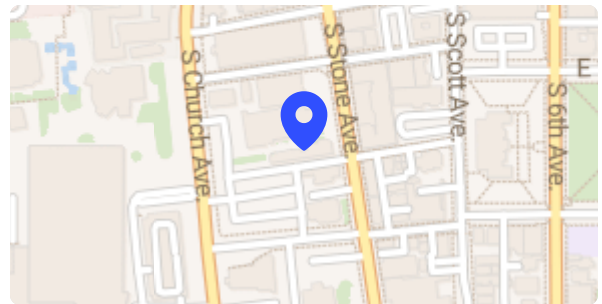

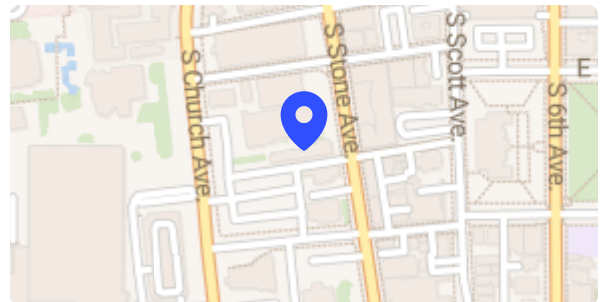
