"**R**aymond Daniel Love died February 11, 2020 at home. He was born at St. Mary's Hospital in Tucson, AZ on December 11, 1941. He worked for Stewart Title and then retired from the United States Postal Service after 34 years. He served in the Army from 1964 to 1966. After getting out of the Army he went to Minneapolis, MN, where he married Lynnette Benson (Love) in 1966. They made Tucson their home, where they had 3 children: Scott (Raeanne), Mark (Sabina), and Melissa (Justin) Conroy, and 7 grandchildren: Kyle, Amberleigh, Naomi, Elijah, Hannah, Zachary, and Kevan Ian. 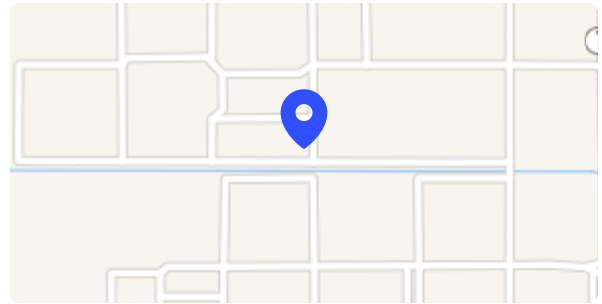

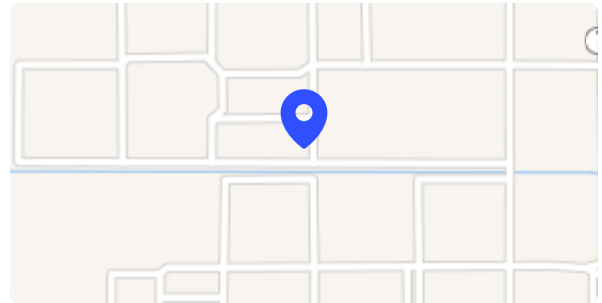

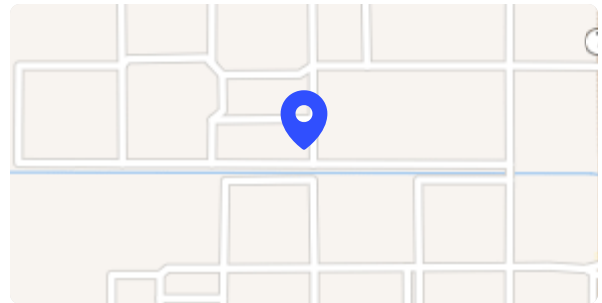
