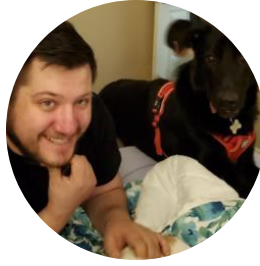

Our beloved Ryan Zelazny, an accomplished Navy Corpsman and Registered Nurse, passed away on May 31st at the age of 29.

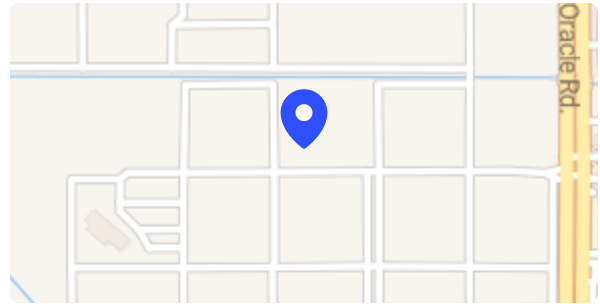
