He was loyal to friends and family and loved telling jokes. He did not live an easy life and spent many years in prison, convicted of a non-violent drug offense. However, despite growing up with dyslexia and ADHD, he attained his GED and learned a great deal about the legal system. He bravely fought a continuous battle with throat cancer, but loved showing off his "ink" (tattoos) to pretty nurses. David was charming and had many friends like his longtime best friend Tracey Akers.

David is survived by his mother Luz (de la Garza) Neville, brother William Patrick Neville, sister Joanna (Michael) Hammond, a biological son Paul (Pam) Pajak, two biological grandchildren Ella and Maddy Pajak, niece Rachel (Greg) Miller, nephew Philip (Kassy) Neville, two great nieces, one great nephew, numerous cousins and extended family. David was preceded in death by his father William D. Neville, sister Mary Angela Neville, and nephew Travis W. Hammond.
